

Salvatorian Sisters' Service Award Awarded to Graduating Seniors

Divine Savior Holy Angel High School's service requirement is a direct reflection of our mission to develop the whole person, rooted in the goodness and kindness of Christ. The Salvatorian Sisters' Service Award recognizes students who have embodied that mission by consistently embracing the call to serve others beyond the graduation service requirement throughout their four years at DSHA. This award is given by the Sisters of the Divine Savior in acknowledgement of the young woman the senior has become through her time at DSHA and the lives she will change through her future service.

Eligibility:

- Complete 120+ hours of service freshmen through junior year. All service to poor & vulnerable persons, DSHA, place of worship/parish, summer service, and mission trips** can be applied to this cumulative goal.
- Complete 20+ hours of ongoing service during senior year between the 1st day of school and the last day of the fall semester. At least 10 of these hours need to be at one site.

Implementation

This change went into effect as of May 31, 2017 so the adjusted requirements for Class of 2019 are:

- Complete 100+ hours of service freshmen through junior year, All service to poor & vulnerable persons, DSHA, place of worship/parish, summer service, and mission trips** can be applied to this cumulative goal.
- Complete 20+ hours of service during senior year between 1st day of school and the last day of fall semester. At least 10 of these hours need to be at one site.

Class of 2020 onward will be eligible for the award using these new requirements above.

^{*}All service must be submitted, verified, and approved through x2VOL.

^{**}Each mission/service trip or parish retreat/VBS leadership can be applied up to 20 hours toward the Salvatorian Sister's Service Award.
